CLUB BYE-LAWS

PARENTAL RESPONSIBILITY

We pride ourselves on being a family orientated club which means children are welcome. However, as a licenced premises it is an adult environment & children need to be supervised at all times. Children must stay with parents and be kept under strict control. Parents will be asked to vacate club premises, with their children if misbehaviour occurs. Should misbehaviour continue the children concerned will be refused entry to the club.

FOOD

Only under special circumstances, as agreed by the committee, may food be brought onto the club premises. Only food purchased on club premises may be consumed at the club.

DOG OWNERS

All dogs must be kept on a lead and under the control of a suitable adult at all times. Please do not tie up your dog's lead to the table you are occupying. Dogs must not be on the furniture unless a suitable barrier is used to protect the furniture from hair and dirt.

DARTBOARDS

No children under the age of 12 are allowed to play on the dartboards without supervision by a responsible adult.

POOL TABLE

Children under the age of 12 are not allowed to play pool without supervision by a responsible adult.

MEMBERSHIPS

May we remind members that paid membership must be proved on request. We would, therefore, ask you to always carry your card. All guests must be signed in. Members can sign in up to two guests at a time, with each guest contributing £1 to the donation box at the door. Guests that are eligible for membership may only be signed in once per month.

POOL/DARTS TEAM

Extract rule 7(1) 'Members shall not be less than 18 years of age' As stated in this rule persons under the age of 18 cannot become members of the club and as such cannot represent the club in any pool or darts team. Only fully paid-up members may represent the club in the teams or at the discretion of the committee.

FUNCTIONS APPROVED BY THE CLUB COMMITTEE

As stated, in club rules 13.3, any member wishing to hold a function at the club, must put it in writing to the Club Committee. The Club Committee will consider the application and confirm to the member in writing. Lapsed members (with the approval of the Club Committee) will be allowed in the club for parties and funerals only. A notice will be put up, in the foyer, before the event notifying other members. During the event, it is the responsibility of the organiser to ensure that all guest act appropriately.

MEMBERS OF THE CLUB COMMITTEE

Members of the club committee cannot also sit on the branch committee during the same term. There are no exceptional circumstances to warrant this.

PAYMENT TO COMMITTEE MEMBERS

All costs paid to committee members must be discussed and recorded at committee meetings. Any payments made to committee members must be disclosed, by them, to HMRC.

OFFICERS OF THE CLUB COMMITTEE

To be elected as an officer of the club a term of 2 years must be completed as a club committee member first. This relates to current committee, not a past committee.

FINALLY, WE DRAW YOUR ATTENTION TO PART 21 OF THE CLUB

RULES

No gaming (other than that permitted by law) drunkenness, bad language or other misconduct will be permitted on the club premises.

Any officer duly authorised by the committee shall have the power to order the immediate withdrawal/suspension from the club premises of any member offending under any provisions of this rule until investigated and/or suspension is lifted.
